

**MINUTES OF THE PARISH COUNCIL MEETING HELD ON MONDAY 24 SEPTEMBER  
2018 AT 7.30PM IN THE VILLAGE HALL**

3. HATTENS FARM NURSERIES PLANNING APPLICATION. DC/18/03507

Mr E Krutysza presented the proposal for a two bedroom 180 sq m residential development on Hattens Farm Nurseries that had been submitted to the District Council. He explained the plans and his supporting documents.

Mrs Cecelia Pryce Joined the meeting at 7.38 pm.

After a brief discussion including the supporting views of the members of the public attending the meeting, the Chairman declared that the support for this development was unanimously agreed and that the Planning Officer, Sian Bunbury, should be notified.

4. LIGHTING OF BEACON - UPDATE.
